The Smithville Area Fire Protection District is seeking qualified applicants to fill 3 new Firefighter-EMT positions. SAFD serves the City of Smithville and 112 square miles of Clay and Platte counties on the northern border of Kansas City, MO. In addition to fire/rescue responses, SAFD provides non-transport BLS medical response with fire apparatus. **SAFD does not provide ambulance transport, EMS transport is provided by a separate service**.

Starting salary is \$48,255.48 annually. The District has a contract with IAFF L-4945, current contract includes step raises through 2025. SAFD works the 48 hours on / 96 hours off schedule The District pays 100% of the health insurance premium for the employee and 50% of the premium for family coverage. Insurance includes health, dental, vision, and short-term disability. The District also provides a Lagers Level 7 retirement benefit. Vacation leave, sick leave, and bereavement leave are all provided. The District pays an hourly educational incentive. The District also pays an hourly incentive for fire apparatus operators. There is no residency requirement.

Hiring requirements include:

19 years of age,

Certified Firefighter 1 and 2,

Missouri licensed or Nationally Registered EMT or Paramedic (those with National Registry must be able to obtain an EMT or Paramedic license from the State of Missouri),

An acceptable driving record

An acceptable background after a thorough investigation

A clean drug screen

Ability to pass a medical/fit for duty physical

CPAT and Fire Service Entrance Exam <u>not</u> required

Candidates who are still in the academy, or those waiting to test, are encouraged to apply. Final offers will be contingent on obtaining the required certifications.
